This is for information of all that two company CAPF personnel (around 250), who had taken accommodation in the College Building in connection with the W.B. Assembly Election, 2026 since 26.04.2026, have left the College around noon today. The Amherst Street P.S., although, took over the College building on 13.04.2026 and the College was kept closed from 16.04.2026 due to removal of benches from class rooms for the possibility of CAPF arrival in the College.

As per information received from the Amherst P.S., the benches gathered in the balconies will be re-arranged in the respective class rooms tomorrow. The sweepers of the three colleges will also clean all the class rooms and balconies on all floors tomorrow and the day after under guidance of common caretaker Sri Uchit Kumar Das. The College will be therefore ready for normal activities and classes.

All College Offices, Departments and Library will reopen from the next Monday (i.e. 11.05.2026) and normal College activities, classes and Office works will resume from this date. All teaching and non-teaching staffs are required to arrive at College on time, sign the attendance register and provide their biometric attendance as usual.


