- ① Prof. Mitali Roy and Prof. Pampa Guha, both the joined convenors started the meeting with a welcome note.
- Prof. Mitali Roy proposed to take some basic classes for awareness to the ~~poor~~ children ^{who lives besides road} of nearby of college. Max. 1 or 2 hours of classes per week will be taken. Some foods (light) will be provided to them at the time of taking class. The main aim is to provide some basic knowledge / awareness to the childrens nearby college. Prof. Mitali Roy also suggested if some clothes be provided to them at the time of 'Poila Baishakh'.
- ② Prof. Mitali Roy also suggested for a survey for the childrens of nearby college. Prof. Pampa Guha suggested to organise a seminar regarding 'Diabetes Awareness Camp' for them.
- ③ Whatever initiative had taken previously, the condition should be ensured.
- Prof. Rita Chanda suggested to provide the childrens ~~to~~ some note books and some light foods.
- Minimum budget:
Food packet per week $15 \times 12 = 180/-$
Stationary items for first time minimum 500/-
Total expenses (per month) = 1200/- (approx)
